Aberdeen Housing Update

UPDATE: Accommodations while we are in Aberdeen--just the first two nights--have changed from university housing with single rooms to a hotel with double rooms (two beds and a shared bathroom). We recognize that this is a significant shift from what was described in our informational meeting last May, and how our previous tours have been planned. However, this change impacts the sleeping arrangements for the first two nights of the tour ONLY--all other overnights are single room, dormitory housing with separate shower rooms, private toilet stalls, etc.

Our tour budget allows us to assign two singers per hotel room.

We recognize there may be privacy (or other) concerns related to sharing a room while on tour. We are especially thinking about our trans and gender fluid singers who may have additional questions or need particular accommodations. The form introduced below provides space for you to communicate those to us, but also feel free to reach out to us at any time.

Planning roommate assignments requires singer and family input.

Please keep reading for how that will be accomplished!

Family Group & Roommate Preferences

The Family Group & Roommate Survey Form will gather confidential input from singers (and families) before family groups and roommate lists are finalized.

We currently have 68 singers on the <u>tour roster</u> from Purcell, Britten, Holst and Ragazzi! To ensure the smooth functioning of our group, we organize our singers into **FAMILY GROUPS** which are led by one chaperone and include a mix of 4-8 singers from any ensemble. We use family groups to move efficiently through airports, for taking attendance (multiple times each day), for creating room blocks, and for organizing our bus rides. **No one is confined to only being with their family group**--everyone has plenty of opportunities to be with tour members outside of their assigned family group. We move as one large group comprised of several smaller family groups!

ROOMMATES will share a hotel room for two nights when we are in Aberdeen. Each double room has two beds, one for each roommate, and a shared bathroom. All other nights on the tour are single room accommodations for everyone.

Students and their parent chaperone may opt to be be roommates.

No singer will be placed in a room with an adult who is not immediate family.

Deviation Requests

Tour participants planning additional time in Europe and not returning with the tour group on June 27, may request a deviation for their return travel arrangements through our air handler.

Submit the <u>Deviation Request Form</u> directly to Gateway per the directions on the form.

Requests must be submitted, completed, and paid in full prior to March 15, 2025.

There are a limited number of deviation requests available, and they will be filled on a first come, first served basis.

Families traveling together after the tour will need to pick up their singer in Edinburgh on Thursday evening, June 26, around 10PM.

Unfortunately, we are not able to accommodate earlier pick ups.

UK Electronic Travel Authorization (ETA) Instructions

These instructions are now posted on the <u>Scotland 2025 webpage</u> for your reference. If you have your passport in hand, you can apply for your ETA today which is now REQUIRED for entry from the United States into the UK for all travelers, regardless of age. We will be requesting a confirmation of your ETA, along with a photo of your passport in late April / early May.

LOOKING AHEAD:

In March we will be requesting the following information needed to finalize the ticketing process:

- Passport-specific NAME and GENDER as listed on the passport you will be carrying in June. Your passport application will have this information, if you don't yet have your passport in hand.
- Delta or Flying Blue number (frequent flyer OPTIONAL)
- Known Traveler Number (OPTIONAL) TSA Pre-Check or Global Entry
- Special meal requests (flight only OPTIONAL)
